JOHN D. MCMAHON **Executive Vice President**

John D. McMahon is Executive Vice President of Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., a wholly-owned subsidiary of Consolidated Edison, Inc., providing electric, gas and steam service to New York City and Westchester County.

Mr. McMahon's responsibilities include oversight of the Company's energy efficiency and demand response programs, its law department, regulatory services and regulatory relations.

Prior to being named to his current position at Con Edison in February 2009, Mr. McMahon served in a number of positions, including President and CEO of Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. and General Counsel of Con Edison, Inc.

Mr. McMahon joined Con Edison in 1976 as an attorney in the rate proceedings department. In 1992, he received Con Edison's "Living Our Values" award, the Company's highest employee award.

A graduate of Manhattan College and New York Law School, Mr. McMahon has also completed the Advanced Management Program of Harvard Business School and Wharton Business School.

Con Edison of New York provides electric service to approximately 3.2 million customers and gas service to approximately 1.1 million customers in New York City and Westchester County. The company also provides steam service in parts of Manhattan. Its parent company, Consolidated Edison, Inc., is one of the nation's largest investor-owned energy companies, with \$13 billion in annual revenues and approximately \$29 billion in assets.
