DSS ADD GOES LIVE!

The NYISO is announcing the release of the Decision Support System's (DSS) Alternate Data Delivery (ADD) interface. The DSS ADD interface was implemented as planned on July 7, 2004, and now is available for Market Participants to request and download their Hourly and Daily Customer Settlement files (CSV advisories).

Market Participants with access to the DSS can access the ADD interface through the links provided on the DSS home page (Business Objects InfoView). Additional information is available in NYISO's Technical Bulletin #127 – Accessing Customer Statement Files through the Decision Support System (DSS).

DSS ADD is a new data interface available to Market Participants. This interface publishes the existing hourly and daily customer statement files (advisories), and allows Market Participants to obtain these reports in a more efficient automated data exchange process. DSS ADD replaces the existing static web posting system for both the hourly and daily advisories, and the dynamic MIS upload/download process for the daily advisory.

NOTE: This change is only to the delivery mechanism by which these files are made available to Market Participants, and does not affect existing settlement advisory file layouts or data content. It also does not affect other MIS upload/download data templates.

The DSS ADD Timeline includes the following remaining milestones:

- 08/31/2004 – Halt existing Static & Dynamic Advisory processes

The ADD timeline is designed to provide Market Participants 2 invoicing months to verify their ADD interfacing capabilities.

- 10/01/2004 – Remove static website & distribute CDs containing historical files

Historical files currently posted on the static website will be provided to Market Participants on CDs when the website is removed.

So, what does DSS ADD mean to you? You will need to use ADD if you are currently capturing your hourly and/or daily customer settlement files (or would like to in the future). And, if you are looking for even more data, remember DSS is your primary source for NYISO Customer Settlements Data! DSS contains a broad set of NYISO data that can be used for a variety of purposes by a large user community. Contact your NYISO Customer Relations Representative for more information.
