I am pleased to hereby submit the New York Independent System Operator (NYISO) 2007 FERC Form No. 715, Annual Transmission Planning and Evaluation Report. The NYISO is submitting a Paperless filing again this year. As instructed, the filing is being submitted on the enclosed CDs: the first CD contains the entire report except the Part 2 power flow bases cases, and the second CD contains the Part 2 power flow base cases (input and output for six power flow base cases), an associated data-dictionary, and the EIA plant codes for generating plants referenced.
