Release 1 Pilot Discussion

> What to Expect

- Conducted at the NYISO offices in Albany, NY
- Data will be real, however masked to maintain confidentiality
- Common scenarios will be used to demonstrate the primary capabilities of the DSS
- 3 Business Objects Universes will be available (loads, generators, and transmission customers), with organization-level security
- This is a pilot, so...
 - Data issues may still exist prior to final release to the market
 - Standard reports will be limited and focused on most common formats
 - Metadata will be limited to data element names and some descriptions
- Desired Outcomes:
 - Issues and questions that remain unresolved will be captured and addressed at a later date
 - Feedback will be collected from the attending Market Participants in order to make necessary enhancements prior to final release



Data Masking Strategy

- Data used during the Pilot on 12/20 will be masked to maintain confidentiality
 - Strategy:
 - Modify names, IDs, descriptions, contact info, etc. so that users will be unable to recognize data
 - Data presented will be real data (actual data from a test month)
 - No one will remove data from the pilot location (electronic or hardcopy)
 - Data will be from a test period at least 6 months old (May 2002 data)



Desired Use Patterns and Access Paths

- Continued from last meeting...

 - How will you organize, group, filter, sort, etc.?
 - What types of reports do you plan to build?
 - What questions do you plan to answer using the data?
 - What combination of elements is of value?
