

# IPPTF Issue Track 5 Work Plan- DRAFT

## IPPTF Purpose

To incorporate the cost of carbon dioxide into wholesale energy markets with the goal of contributing to achieving New York State’s public policies, while providing the greatest benefits at the least cost to consumers and appropriate price signals to incentivize investment and maintain grid reliability.

## Issue Track 5: Consumer Impacts

This document sets out a work plan for Issue Track 5. The Joint Staff team will analyze how a carbon price affects the wholesale market dispatch as well as how the allocation of carbon revenues will affect customer bills. The proposed methodology and the assumptions used in the analysis will be reviewed along with the stakeholder provided feedback (see topics listed below) in April and May. The results of the analysis will be presented in September and October. Any stakeholders wishing to present should contact the Joint Staff team at least two weeks prior to the meeting date.
