Changes Made to Initial CARIS Manual

- Replacement of excerpts from Attachment Y with citations
- Update of all Attachment Y citations to conform to latest approved tariff
- Addition to the Manual of previously approved and currently posted Request Forms and Agreements for Additional CARIS Studies, CARIS 2 Specific Studies, and Replication
- Corrections to terminology to conform to tariff
- •Formatting, typos, capitalization, and punctuation as needed




Next Steps
