Participant. The ISO shall disclose data that is not Confidential Information, and information required to be disclosed by FERC, by posting the information on the OASIS. If an ISO Employee improperly discloses TSI to any Market Participant, the ISO shall immediately post the information on the OASIS and notify the Commission. Notwithstanding this Section, the ISO may disclose Confidential Information related to External Transactions as provided in Attachment H to the ISO Services Tariff.

ISO Employees shall also report all improper disclosures of Confidential Information to the ISO compliance officer (as described in Section 10.0) or its designee immediately. In the case of an Emergency, the ISO may disclose such TSI, and then notify the Commission, posting the information on the OASIS as soon as practicable but no later than twenty-four (24) hours after the information is disclosed.

The procedures described in this Section does not apply to the following:

- (1) communication of TSI between the ISO and the Transmission Owner's control centers, and other power pools or ISOs;
- (2) communication of information from a Market Participant to the ISO;
- information that is no longer Confidential Information because it was (3) made public by posting it on the OASIS; or it was legally disclosed by a third party in good faith and without violating a trade secret, secrecy
