Note that the NYISO's Open Access Transmission Tariff ("OATT") was revised (effective September 13, 2008) to clarify that studies voluntarily undertaken by customers are not subject to the *pro forma* OATT's sixty day completion deadline.<sup>2</sup> In addition, the revised NYISO OATT requires the NYISO to tender draft SIS agreements thirty days after the scope of the SIS is approved by the stakeholder Operating Committee, rather than within thirty days of the receipt of a study request as under the *pro forma* OATT.

As shown on Table 1, eight (8) SISs were in progress at the end of the quarter, four (4) by NYISO and four (4) by the customer, or their respective consultants. For the four studies being performed by the NYISO, draft study reports or preliminary results have been provided to the customer for review and feedback. During the quarter, one study was completed, no new study requests were received, and two (2) study requests were withdrawn. One study agreement was offered, as required, and is pending execution by the customer. The obligation to tender study agreements for the two most recent study requests has not been triggered because the study scopes are still under review by the customer and is pending approval by the NYISO's Operating Committee.

The NYISO is not aware of any new Facilities Study agreements being delivered or conducted by New York's Transmission-Owning utilities during the quarter. Under the NYISO OATT, the Transmission Owners, not the NYISO, are responsible for Facilities Studies.
