Note that the NYISO’s Open Access Transmission Tariff (“OATT”) was revised (effective September 13, 2008) to clarify that studies voluntarily undertaken by customers are not subject to the *pro forma* OATT’s sixty day completion deadline.² In addition, the revised NYISO OATT requires the NYISO to tender draft SIS agreements thirty days after the scope of the SIS is approved by the stakeholder Operating Committee, rather than within thirty days of the receipt of a study request as under the *pro forma* OATT.

As shown on Table 1, two SISs were completed during the 3rd quarter and ten SISs were in progress at the end of the quarter, four by NYISO and six by the customer, or their respective consultants. One study agreement was offered for a new request received in the previous quarter and was pending execution of the agreement and approval of the scope. No new study requests were received during the 3rd quarter.

The NYISO is not aware of any new Facilities Study agreements being delivered or conducted by New York's Transmission-Owning utilities during the quarter. Under the NYISO OATT, the Transmission Owners, not the NYISO, are responsible for Facilities Studies.
