### **Solicitation of Stakeholder Representatives for 2005 Eastern RTO/ISO Conference “Examining Wholesale Electricity Markets”**

Date: May 11 & 12, 2005 – Marriott (Metro Center), Washington, D.C.

#### **Roundtable Discussion Format**

##### **Discussion Topics**

- 1) Resource Adequacy, Long Term Planning & Reliability
- 2) Market Monitoring
- 3) Market Seams
- 4) Emerging Initiatives – RPS, RGGI, CAIR, Mercury

##### **Discussion Format**

Each ISO/RTO will have a stakeholder representative from the supplier, transmission, and end use segments for each discussion topic above. Accordingly, every discussion topic roundtable will include nine (9) market participants. This complement will include a supply, transmission, and end use representative from each ISO/RTO. One representative from each segment (supplier, transmission, & end use) will present formal comments.

The smaller segment subgroups for each discussion topic will determine who will make the formal comments. The formal comment period will be restricted to approximately 2 minutes for each segment or a total of 6 minutes of formal comments for all three segments combined.

Upon completion of the formal comments, a Q & A session with the commissioners and nine stakeholder representatives will occur. All topic representatives will have the opportunity to engage in the Q & A session on the topic. Each panel discussion topic will last approximately 25 minutes. (Six minutes of formal comments, and the remainder for Q & A).

It is possible for a segment within an ISO/RTO to elect to have the same representative present more than one-discussion topics. I have attached the conference agenda for your review.

Accordingly, we need segment representatives for each discussion topic. Please discuss this today during our meeting. I would like all participating speakers identified by Friday. Upon completion, I will forward a complete contact list so representatives from the three ISOs can coordinate their respective segment’s formal comments.
