Request for Proposal sent to vendors	Mid-December
Vendor intent to respond	Third week of December
Vendors submit questions to NYISO	First week of January
NYISO returns consolidated list of questions to vendors	Second week of January
NYISO teleconference to answer vendor questions	Second week of January
RFP responses due to NYISO	Late January
RFP status notice to vendors	Early – Mid February
RFP finalist presentations	Mid – Late February
Vendor selection	By end of Q1 2009
