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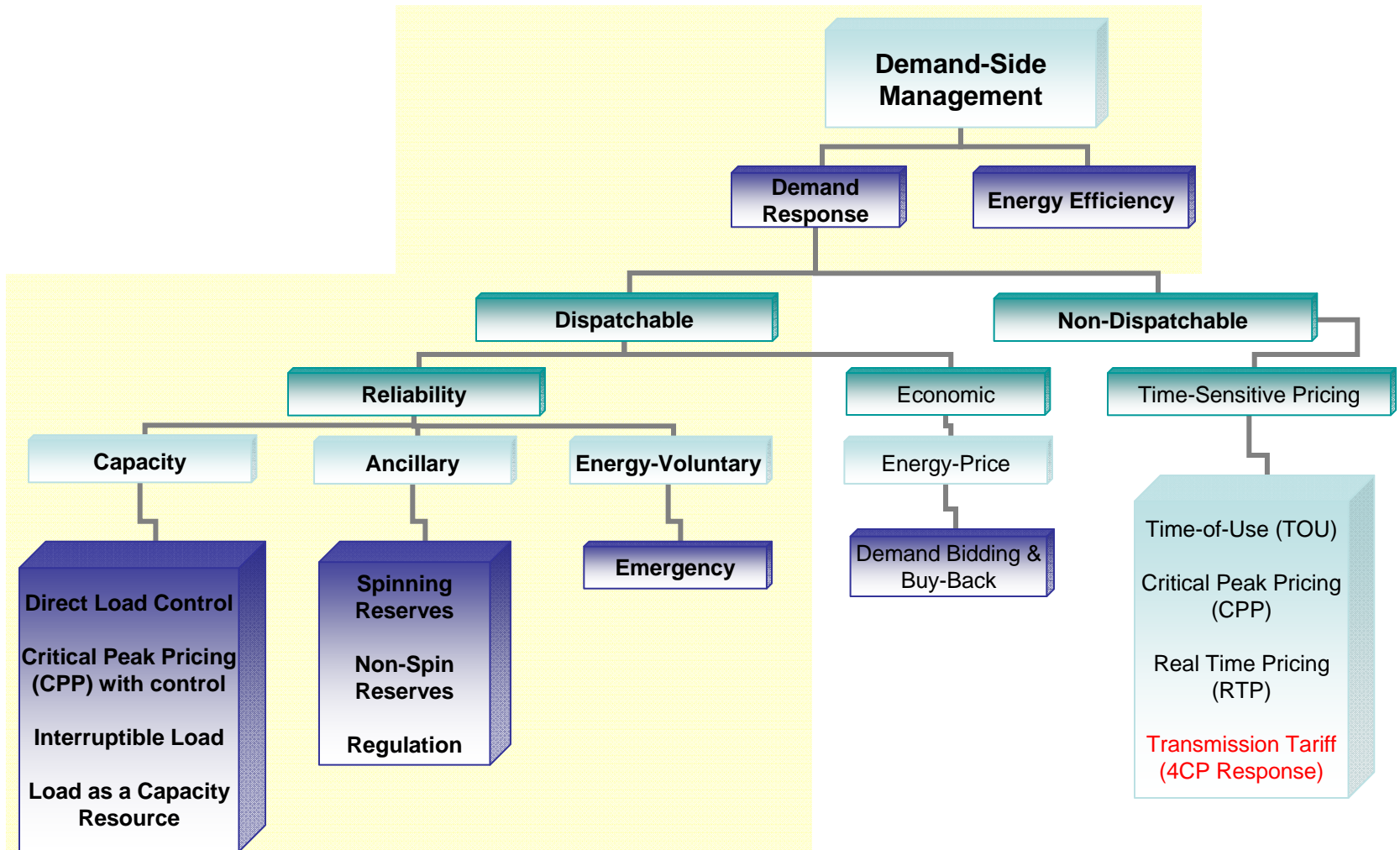

DRDTF Activities (March – July 2008)

- ◆ March – June

- *Developed work plan for the Task Force*
- *Developed a data collection worksheet for ISO/RTO-administered demand response programs*

- ◆ July 2008

- *DRDTF prototype data collection worksheet presented to NAESB to encourage retail entities to provide feedback on additional reporting requirements*
- *Rick Sergel, President & CEO of NERC presented to NARUC that NERC will be developing a Demand Response Availability Data System (DADS) to help quantify the value of demand response to reliability*

DRDTF Activities (continued)

- ◆ August 2008
 - *Began development of high-level business requirements for the Demand Response Availability Data System (DADS)*
 - *Attempted to map out process for data submission of the demand response reporting data identified in the worksheet that the DRDTF developed*
- ◆ September/October 2008
 - *Continuing to define the business requirements with more specificity*
 - *NERC is working on identifying which entities will be required to submit data to DADS*
