Load Forecasting Task Force

2015 Preliminary Weather Normalized MW for 2016 ICAP Forecast (V2)

Arthur Maniaci of the NYISO presented an update of the 2015 preliminary Weather Normalized MW for the 2016 NYISO ICAP forecast. The forecast is derived from NYISO actual load settlement data, load data from Transmission Owners (TOs) and Municipals, TO data on Demand Response and generation resources located behind the meter and TO weather adjustments. The NYISO has provided economic forecast data received from Moody's Analytics to TOs to assist in the derivation of their Regional Load Growth factors. The load, which will continue to be revised until all data is finalized, currently stands at 33,184.3MW. The next review of the preliminary Weather Normalized MW for the 2016 NYISO ICAP forecast will be at the LFTF meeting of December 7, 2015.
