Joint Market Issues/Price Responsive Load/Installed Capacity Working Group

2014 RNA Scenarios

Yachi Lin of the NYISO presented the revised list of scenarios to be examined for the 2014 Reliability Needs Assessment (RNA). Ms. Lin appeared at the April 11, 2014 ESPWG/TPAS meeting with a preliminary list of suggested scenarios and determined, with stakeholder input, the following scenarios will be studied:

- Dunkirk Status Variation
 - The Dunkirk RSS status not selected for the base case will be used as a scenario
- High Load (Econometric) Forecast
- Transmission security assessment using 90/10 load forecast
- Zonal capacity at risk
 - Including a resource adequacy assessment
 - Including an Indian Point Retirement assessment

Stakeholders requested clarification on how the proposed transmission upgrades in Western NY (surrounding the Dunkirk resolution) would be addressed in the base case. The NYISO agreed to review the base case and return with a clarification on how this transmission would be modeled. A final scenario under consideration is to test stressed winter conditions by limiting energy. This would include a resource adequacy assessment and will be applied to all resource types, state-wide. The result would report on the levels of energy that could be limited before LOLE is violated in the RNA. Stakeholders requested that the NYISO present an assumption matrix at the next ESPWG and the NYISO agreed to the request. Ms. Lin pointed out that the base case will be presented in May prior to the scenarios being done in June. To see the NYISO presentation, please go to:
