Compliance Filing

- The NYISO made its compliance filing on February 1, 2013
 - Requested an order by April 2, 2013 to allow tariff to become effective prior to the Summer 2013 Capability Period enrollment deadline of April 8, 2013
- Tariff revisions included:
 - Changes to definitions of Average Coincident Load, Provisional Average Coincident Load, and Special Case Resource
 - Revisions to Section 5.12.11.1



ICAP Manual Changes to Incorporate Stakeholder Feedback

- Section 4.2.2, 4.12.4.8, 4.12.7
 - Additional instances of distributed generator changed to Local Generator
- Section 4.12
 - Modified definition of Special Case Resource to be consistent with proposed tariff changes
- Section 4.12.4
 - Clarify that the generation reporting requirement for NYCA and Locality peak does not apply to amount of generation normally operating to serve Load


