### Informational Notice of Effective Date of the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. In Docket No. ER05-1123-000

Dear Ms. Salas:

The Commission, in its July, 19, 2005 order ("RTD Order") in this proceeding,<sup>1</sup> conditionally accepted for filing a New York Independent System Operator, Inc. ("NYISO")-proposed Tariff amendment to remedy price volatility in the Real-Time Market. The NYISO respectfully submits this Notice of Effective Date, for informational purposes. The NYISO is providing notice that the enhancement to remedy price volatility in the Real-Time Market will go into effect on August 3, 2005.<sup>2</sup> Issues around testing the newly developed software and the extraordinary system Loads that the NYISO has been experiencing since July 19, 2005 required a short delay in implementation of this new functionality. The NYISO greatly appreciates the Commission's quick action on its request.

The NYISO will submit, on August 18, 2005, the compliance filing requested by the Commission.
