

Demand Side Ancillary Services Program (DSASP) Direct Communication Headroom

DSASP Resources must establish 6-second telemetry communications prior to participating in DSASP. Telemetry communications may be either (i) established directly with the NYISO, or (ii) established with the DSASP Resource's respective Transmission Owner. The NYISO has established a NYCA-wide limit of 200 MW for DSASP Resources directly communicating with the NYISO in order to limit the amount of Operating Reserves that are not under Transmission Owner control during Interim Control Operations. However, MW provided by DSASP Resources directly communicating with the NYISO do not count against the NYCA-wide limit when the applicable Transmission Owner has established alternative communication procedures to maintain reliability during Interim Control Operations.
