## Management Committee Meeting

January 27, 2009 Comfort Inn

## **SUMMARY OF MOTIONS**

## Motion #1:

The Management Committee (MC) hereby recommends that the NYISO Board of Directors authorize the NYISO to file with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, pursuant to Section 205 of the Federal Power Act, tariff revisions to the Open Access Transmission Tariff and the Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff to improve and clarify the billing and payment provisions of the NYISO tariffs, as approved by the Business Issues Committee on December 17, 2008, and as is more fully described in the presentation made to the MC meeting on January 27, 2009.

Motion passed unanimously by show of hands.

#### Motion #2:

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2004, the Management Committee approved the allocation among Market Participants of the portion of the NYISO's Rate Schedule 1 charges related to NYISO's operating budget and FERC fees (hereinafter "Rate Schedule 1 Charges") as 80% to withdrawal billing units and 20% to injection billing units;

WHEREAS, in that same action, the Management Committee approved the new allocation to be effective for a minimum of five years, commencing on January 1, 2005, and to be reviewed during the fourth quarter of 2008 to determine if significant market changes occurred to merit adjustment of the 80%/20% allocation;

WHEREAS, those changes were approved by NYISO's Board of Directors and FERC, and became effective in both the NYISO's Open Access Transmission Tariff and NYISO's Services Tariff as of January 1, 2005;

WHEREAS, in compliance with those tariff provisions, the NYISO has reviewed whether significant market changes have occurred that would merit changing the 80%/20% allocation as detailed in its December 3, 2008 Management Committee Presentation; and WHEREAS, in accordance with the tariff provisions NYISO Staff has found that no significant market changes occurred to merit revision of the allocation methodology at that time.

NOW THEREFORE, based upon the analyses performed by the NYISO Staff, as included in its December 3, 2008 Management Committee Presentation, the Management Committee hereby agrees with, and approves the following provisions for going forward to be set forth in the NYISO's tariffs and requests tht the NYISO Board approves same and direct NYISO staff to submit a filing to the FERC under FPA 205 filing to effectuate these changes:

- ° The current percentage allocation between loads and supply shall be extended without change through at least December 31, 2011 (a minimum two-year extension).
- ° In Q3, 2010, a vote will be taken on whether a new study should be conducted during late-2010 and 2011 to allow a new percentage allocation, if warranted by the results of the study, to be implemented by January 1, 2012. A positive vote of 58% will

be needed to go forward with the study, but there will no longer be a "material change" standard applied to the determination.

- ° If the Q3 2010 vote results in a determination that a study should not be conducted, the current percentage allocation between loads and supply shall be extended through at least December 31, 2012. In Q3 2011, a vote will be taken on whether a new study should be conducted during late-2011 and 2012 to allow a new percentage allocation, if warranted by the results of the study, to be implemented by January 1, 2013. Unless a vote of 58% is registered in favor of declining to go forward with the study, the study will be conducted.
- ° If the Q3 2011 vote results in a determination that a study should not be conducted, the current percentage allocation remains unchanged until such point a study is held and the results of the study warrant making a change to it. If the Q3 2011 vote results in a determination that study should not be conducted, the issue of whether a study should be conducted will be revisited annually in the third quarter using the same voting standard as was applied in the Q3 2011 vote.
- ° If and when a study is conducted, it shall be completed and its results shared with Market Participants before the end of Q2 of the year prior to the date on which a possible change to the current allocation may become effective.
- ° As occurs in the demand curve reset process, a draft study scope will be presented to Market Participants for consideration and comment before the NYISO issues the scope as part of its RFP process to retain a consultant to perform the study. A meeting will be held to discuss the components that should be included in the draft study scope before the draft is issued by the NYISO (e.g., categories of costs considered, allocation of benefits, unbundling, etc.).
- ° Consistent with the terms of the RS 1 motion passed at the December 2008 MC meeting, the NYISO will continue its work to analyze applying RS 1 charges to those entities that are not currently assessed these fees. Any approach that is adopted as a result of that effort will be incorporated into, and superimposed on, the results of any study that is conducted.

### Motion #3:

The Management Committee ("MC") hereby agrees with the changes suggested by NYISO Staff to conform the NYISO's Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff ("Services Tariff") with the NYISO's current practice in developing the statewide load forecast as it relates to utilizing Load Serving Entities load forecasts, all as more fully described in the presentation made to the MC on January 27, 2009, and approves the attached tariff language to implement such changes.

The MC further requests that the NYISO's Board of Directors approve these determinations and direct NYISO Staff to submit a tariff filing with these changes to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission under Section 205 of the Federal Power Act.

Motion passed unanimously.

### Motion # 4:

The Management Committee hereby approves changes to the NYISO's Tariff's with regard to wind resource management as more fully described in the presentations made to the BIC on January 14, 2009 and the MC on January 27, 2009; provided, however, the NYISO previously has provided information demonstrating that the penalty provisions set forth in the NYISO's tariff have acted as a sufficient deterrent to over-generation as they currently have been applied to suppliers.

Given that a new application of these rules is being proposed with these tariff changes, the Management Committee further requests that: (i) the NYISO provide reports on a quarterly basis for the first year that this rule is in place detailing whether this new rule has worked as intended; and (ii) after the first year, the NYISO work together with Dr. David Patton and request that he incorporate within his annual State of the Markets Reports an analysis of whether the penalty mechanisms continue to operate as intended as applied to all suppliers.

Motion passed unanimously with abstentions.

### Motion #5:

The Management Committee hereby approves changes to the NYISO's Tariff's with regard to limited energy storage market design as more fully described in the presentation made to the MC on January 27, 2009.

Motion passed unanimously with abstentions.

#### Motion #6:

The Management Committee hereby approves revisions to the amendments the Management Committee approved November 10, 2008 to Attachment H of the Market Services tariff to clarify categories of conduct that may warrant mitigation for failure to follow basepoint instructions, consistent with the tariff provisions presented to the Management Committee this date, and recommends to the Board that it authorize a Section 205 filing.

Motion passed unanimously with abstentions.

### Motion #7:

The Management Committee hereby recommends that the NYISO Board of Directors authorize the NYISO to file with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, pursuant to Section 205 of the Federal Power Act, tariff revisions to the NYISO Open Access Transmission Tariff and the Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff to adopt procedures in the NYISO tariffs for the assignment and collection of the costs of penalties levied against the NYISO by NERC and other regulatory authorities, pursuant to the presentation made at the Management Committee meeting held on January 27, 2009. The final copy of the Tariffs will be presented to the Chairs and Vice Chairs of the MC, BIC & OC for review and approval and copies distributed to the members of the Management Committee.

Motion passed unanimously with abstentions.

### Motion #8:

The Management Committee hereby recommends that the Board of Directors authorize the NYISO to file with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, pursuant to Section 205 of the Federal Power Act, the proposed changes to the Market Services Tariff as presented to the Management Committee January 27, 2009 including those to impose 75-day reporting requirements for the Emergency Demand Response Program and for Special Case Resources.

Motion passed by majority.
