Background

- During the development of the Interconnection Compliance Filing a number of Market Participants indicated a desire to examine a deliverability product for NY
- In the filing letter to FERC, the NYISO stated that it would conduct an analysis of the impact of a deliverability requirement for New York, including cost allocation and grandfathering issues, within 6 months of the filing.

Initial Meeting Discussions

- Discussion of definition/study scope & objectives
- Some stakeholders questioned the need for a change to current NYISO practice
- Implications for ICAP market were discussed
- PJM deliverability requirement was reviewed
- Locational deliverability was discussed
- NYISO to draft a study scope to reflect IITF discussions for presentation at the next meeting
