



by the Commission, as well as a complete version of the NYISO's Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff ("Services Tariff"), within 15 days of the date of the *Letter Order*, *i.e.*, January 2, 2001.

The NYISO has been working on filing a complete, appropriately designated version of its Services Tariff; however, that filing was only going to reflect filings accepted by the Commission as of September 1, 2000.<sup>2</sup> Pursuant to the *Letter Order*, the NYISO instead will submit its designated Services Tariff reflecting all filings accepted by the Commission through January 2, 2001. The expanded scope of the filing, along with the intervening holidays, and travel commitments and illnesses among the NYISO staff, necessitate the requested extension of time.

### **III. Conclusion**

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. respectfully requests that the Commission grant its request for an extension of time, until January 16, 2001, to submit its compliance filing.
