Proposed Effective Date

The NYISO requests waiver of the 60-day notice period and proposes to make this filing effective on
January 2, 2001.

Brief Description of the Rate Schedule Change

The NYISO makes no changes to the substance of either of its tariffs with this filing.

Statement of the Reasons for the Rate Schedule Change

The NYISO files its Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff to comply with Order No. 614, which established rules for uniform designation of electric rate schedules, and the Commission's Letter Order. By this filing, the NYISO intends to make no changes to the substance of its tariff. The filing reflects all filings accepted by the Commission through January 2, 2001. The filing reflects the NYISO's September 22, 2000 filing in Docket No. ER00-3740-000, which was accepted by the Commission on November 21, 2000. The September 22, 2000 filing incorporated and modified language from the NYISO's April 28, 2000 compliance filing in ER00-1483-000. The April 28, 2000 filing still awaits Commission action. This filing contains all of the language from the accepted September 22, 2000 filing, including the still pending language from the April 28, 2000 filing, to allow for consistency and comprehensibility. The filing does not reflect the NYISO's June 15, 2000 compliance filing in Docket No. ER00-1969-000, which still awaits Commission action.

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The NYISO also files portions of its OATT in order to update the filing of the complete OATT made on November 15, 2000. The November 15, 2000 filing reflected Commission Orders through September 1, 2000. This filing reflects Commission orders since that date. In particular, the filing includes: 1) Revisions to OATT Schedule 1, submitted pursuant to the December 18, 2000 Letter Order; 2) Revisions to OATT Schedule 1, accepted by the Commission on October 23, 2000 in Docket No. ER00-3736-000; 3) Revisions to OATT Rate Schedule 5, accepted by the Commission on November 8, 2000 in Docket Nos. ER00-3591-000 *et al.*; 4) Revisions to OATT Attachment M, accepted by the Commission on October 19, 2000 in ER00-3215-000; and 5) Revisions to OATT Attachment Q, accepted by the Commission on November 21, 2000 in ER01-94-000.

No Costs Relating to Discriminatory Employment Practices

The NYISO has no expenses or costs that have been alleged or judged to be illegal, duplicate, or unnecessary costs that are demonstrably the product of discriminatory employment practices.
