Comments on Cost Allocation and Cost Recovery for Reliability Upgrades New York Energy Buyers Forum

Having reviewed the slides you sent on this matter, the ISO New England/NEPOOL plan mentioned in your "Cost Allocation" slide, and FERC's approval of that plan, following are comments from the New York Energy Buyers Forum.

- 1. When it comes to regulated reliability upgrades, we prefer to maintain the existing venue (i.e., NY PSC) for reviewing such cost allocations rather than having them come under FERC jurisdiction.
- 2. We agree that incentives for construction of regulated reliability upgrades may be essential, but (again) would prefer that such incentives be the subject of a formal PSC rate case.
- 3. We would prefer to keep cost recovery for transmission upgrades performed by regulated utilities under the individual utility tariffs instead of in the NY ISO OATT.
- 4. With regard to cost allocation, we support the creation of reliability criteria if they have a strong consensus basis.
- 5. Due to the special reliability needs of Zone J, we support establishing such guidelines on a case-by-case analysis.
