<u>Motion #1:</u>

Motion to approve the minutes of the July 16, 2008 BIC meeting. (The motion passed unanimously by show of hands)

Motion #2:

The Business Issues Committee (BIC) hereby recommends that the Management Committee approve revisions to Attachment J (Section 5) of the OATT, and Attachment B (Section 3.6) of the Services Tariff as presented to the BIC provided that the BIC requests that the NYISO shall return to the next BIC meeting with a defined schedule including milestones to develop long term market solutions and, once developed, to implement them as expeditiously as possible. In addition, (1) the NYISO will actively work with Market Participants through the Market Issues Working Group to determine whether there is a need to develop additional tariff provisions to discourage future market manipulation in its market and protect Market Participants from bearing the consequences of any future market manipulation, and (2) the NYISO, subject to consultation with FERC staff, will report to the Management Committee at its meeting on September 25, 2008 on when it will be able to present to the Market Issues Working Group its analysis of the financial impact on its markets of the scheduling practices that are the subject of this motion.

Provided, however, that the (1) NYISO agrees that the Discretionary Action Committee or Dispute and claims committee ("DAC") will not be used to address billing issues within the scope of the NYISO tariff's billing and settlement procedures and not be used to settle market participant claims for months for which the bill settlement close-out has been completed, and (2) the NYISO will make a presentation at the next Billing and Accounting Working group to explain the roles and responsibility of the DAC and to consider how to make its activities more transparent to market participants.
