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Main concerns with proposed FCM

Annual vs. seasonal products
Control-area-backed power



Annual vs. Seasonal Products

Currently, only seasonal and monthly products

FCM would move to annual product

HQUS would not qualify

- HQ is a winter-peaking system
- Significant quantities of ICAP available in summer, when most needed in NY
- Loss of HQUS' ICAP would sharply increase auction clearing prices in NY



Annual vs. Seasonal (cont'd)

HQUS supports keeping seasonal auctions

- No annual products in the Voluntary and FP auctions
 - Parties can make annual bilaterals if they wish



Control Area System Resources

Currently, NYISO accepts external ICAP backed by entire control areas (like HQ)

- "Control Area System Resources," see section s.2.32a
- It is unclear whether CASR will be allowed to offer in the FCM
- FCM should retain this feature
