

TCC Auction Schedule

May 2013



Long-term auction schedules should be scheduled/posted well in advance

The current process results in TCC auction schedules posted only weeks prior to commencement

This creates uncertainty on how to focus/deploy internal resources

DC Energy suggests NYISO create a process whereby auction schedules are known well in advance

- CAISO, ISO-NE and MISO schedules known approximately 6 months in advance
- PJM schedule known one-year in advance



Long-term auction schedules should be scheduled/posted well in advance

Recommendation

Spring Long-term Auction

- NYISO distribute survey requesting comments on number of TCC auction rounds on August 1st of prior calendar year.
- Completed surveys due August 15th and NYISO posts results
- Transmission Owners inform NYISO if they are willing to reduce number of rounds by September 15th
- NYISO posts TCC schedule by October 1st

Autumn Long-term Auction

- NYISO distribute survey requesting comments on number of auction rounds on January 5th.
- Completed surveys due January 20th and NYISO posts results
- Transmission Owners inform NYISO if they are willing to reduce number of rounds by February 15th
- NYISO posts TCC schedule March 1st
