- <u>Comprehensive reliability process:</u>
  - Compliance Filing
    - ISO reviewed proposed changes to the Tariff language to address FERC's December order
      - No apparent MP concerns with the ISO's proposed Tariff changes
      - Compliance Filing due late February

# February 7, 2005 meeting

#### • Comprehensive reliability process:

- CRRP data input
  - Schedule for base case data input reviewed by the ISO
    - End of February for MP data inputs
  - Will have a joint call with TPAS in early March to review the base case assumptions
- Implementation criteria for halting a regulated project
  - ISO reported that there has been off line progress but nothing ready for ESPWG review.
- Timeline for The CRRP
  - ESPWG provided comments on revised timeline
  - Required by FERC with the Compliance filing
- Cost Allocation
  - ESPWG began discussion of cost allocation details and MP comments submitted prior to the meeting
  - More to follow in future meetings
- PSC Straw proposal for screening process for alternative regulated proposals
  - Compliance filing removes mandatory screening by the PSC so no need for a formal process
- **PSC Dispute Resolution Process** 
  - Outline provided to ESPWG by PSC Staff
  - Comments/Questions due to PSC by 2/18

#### Comprehensive Planning Process-Economic

- "Strawman Proposal" for the NYISO
  Economic Planning Process to come before
  OC for action on 2/17
  - Reflects a majority but not unanimous position of ESPWG members
  - NYISO intends to include the Economic Planning Process "Strawman" in a status report with FERC due in March
    - ESPWG will focus on the implementation details
