

Developer Qualification Process

While any Developer can respond to a NYISO request for solutions with various solution types, only a Developer determined to be a "Qualified Developer" in any of the RPP, PPTPP, or CARIS Processes shall be eligible to propose transmission-only projects in all of the processes, including in response to solicitations by the NYISO for transmission solutions to Reliability Needs or Public Policy Transmission Needs, and to propose transmission solutions to address specific congestion identified in the CARIS.

Tariff Information

The following sections of Attachment Y of the NYISO Open Access Transmission Tariff ("OATT") describe the requirements to become a Qualified Developer and required response times for both the NYISO and Developers:

- Economic Planning Process (CARIS): OATT 31.3.2.4.1
