II. Motion To Intervene

The NYISO is the independent body responsible for providing open-access transmission service, maintaining reliability, and administering competitive wholesale electricity markets in New York State. This proceeding involves a proposed Interregional Transmission Pilot Program between the PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. ("PJM") and the NYISO. The proposal will allow PJM

to call on certain New York generation to be redispatched to help alleviate congestion in PJM and will allow the NYISO to call on certain PJM generation to be redispatched to help alleviate congestion in New York. The ultimate objective is to develop an interregional operational protocol to facilitate the management of transmission congestion between the Northeastern ISOs during periods when interregional congestion is causing extreme operating conditions to exist in one or more regions. The NYISO therefore has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding which cannot adequately be represented by any other party, and should be permitted to intervene herein.

III. Conclusion

The NYISO respectfully asks that the Commission grant its motion to intervene in this proceeding.
