**MOTION OF THE NEW YORK INDEPENDENT SYSTEM OPERATOR, INC.  
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE ELECTRIC QUARTERLY REPORTS**

Pursuant to Rule 212 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission"), 18 C.F.R. § 385.212 (2003), the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. ("NYISO") respectfully requests that the Commission grant it leave to make the Electric Quarterly Report ("EQR") filings required by Order No. 2001 and its successors,<sup>1</sup> no later than January 15, 2004. Granting this Motion will provide the NYISO with sufficient time to prepare and submit the EQR filings that cover all relevant time periods.

## **II. Motion**

In Order No. 2001, the Commission required public utilities to submit quarterly EQRs covering contracts for jurisdictional services and transactions for power sales. The NYISO's filings will comply with all applicable requirements for the relevant time period in the same manner as the EQRs submitted by comparable Independent System Operators and Regional Transmission Organizations.

While the NYISO intends to fully comply with the Commission's requirements, it recognizes that compiling, inputting, verifying, and filing the information will require considerable time and resources to ensure that the job is done completely and accurately. With that in mind, the NYISO respectfully requests that the Commission allow it until January 15, 2004 to submit the required filings.
