Summary of Feedback Surveys

Comments from the 01/22 Pilot Surveys

- Average feedback rating = 3.81
 - ▶ Pilot achieve desired objectives = 4.00
 - ▶ DSS progress to-date (data and functionality) = 3.80
 - ▶ Level of MP involvement and market communication = 3.60
 - ▶ Pilot facilitation and content = 3.80

General Comments

- The Task Force always asks market participants for input and has held timely meetings to provide feedback.
- ▶ The program is more user friendly than I expected. Once a person masters the basic ideas of this program, I don't think it would be difficult to self-teach to adapt the program to custom needs.
- ▶ A challenge may be with maintaining the DSS with code changes, new settlements. Also, creating tables in BAS that store intermediate calcs that can be refreshed into DSS.
- Meeting 2nd Quarter deadline is also aggressive but will be a challenge.




BO Universe Review

- A Business Objects Universe is a logical way of organizing related data elements in order to facilitate custom query/report creation
- > The DSS currently has defined 3 Universes for Release 1
 - Customer Settlements for Load Serving Entities
 - Customer Settlements for Power Suppliers
 - Customer Settlements for Transaction Customers
- We're looking to make sure we organize data elements in the most efficient way given commonly developed custom queries and reports

User Administration Process

> User Signup Process

- From DSS Homepage
 - ▶ Go to User Access Request Form
 - Complete User Access Request Form
 - Information Required (First/Last Name, Organization, Phone#, Email, Requested Subject Areas, etc.)
 - Submit User Access Request Form to NYISO
- Confirmation Email will be sent by NYISO to email address provided
 - Contains an unsuccessful response, or a successful message with logon and password



User Administration Process

> NYISO Administrative Process

- Receive User Access Request Form via email (from user requesting access)
- Go to internal webpage to view pending User Access Requests
- Approve / reject user application for user access
- Submit approval/rejection to generate User Confirmation Email
