NYS Energy Planning Process

- NYISO is assisting SEP Energy Working Group with inputs and modeling for the electric assessment studies
 - NYSERDA is performing the economic analysis (IPM)
 - NYISO is performing the reliability analysis (MARS)
- Two Reference Cases are being studied:
 - 2009 RNA Base Case
 - Full 15x15 Energy Efficiency Case
- Potential Policy Scenarios Include:
 - 30% RPS Goal
 - Federal CO2 Policy
 - High Demand Forecast
 - Retirement of Indian Point



SEP Process (Cont'd)

- Delays in finalizing the Reference Cases and Policy scenarios IPM analysis will impact NYISO's ability to meet scheduled dates established for the MARS analyses of all Policy Scenarios
- Completion Schedule Extended
 - Draft SEP for Public Comment: July 15th
 - Final SEP: Oct 15th
