## Notice of Initial Decision Period Results to Class Year 2019 NYC Additional SDU Study Projects – Initiation of Second Round

## Dear Developers:

This is to inform you that a Non-Acceptance Event has occurred in the Initial Decision Period for the Class Year 2019 NYC Additional SDU Study ("NYC SDU Study"), and therefore, a Subsequent Decision Period will be required. All Projects, except Q737 El Sunset Park, rejected their respective Cost Allocations.

The NYISO will issue a revised NYC SDU Study report including Revised Project Cost Allocations for SUFs, SDUs and Deliverable MWs, as applicable, by **June 7, 2021**, in accordance with Attachment S of the NYISO Open Access Transmission Tariff.

Once NYISO issues the revised NYC SDU Study report, if there is increase in Project Cost Allocations or decrease in Deliverable MW in the revised NYC SDU Study report, Q737 El Sunset Park will be part of a Subsequent Decision Period. However, if there is no increase in Project Cost Allocations or decrease in Deliverable MW in the revised NYC SDU Study report, (1) Q737 El Sunset Park Developer will not be provided with the option to accept or reject a Revised Project Cost Allocation in a Subsequent Decision Round, (2) NYISO will issue a notice for Q737 El Sunset Park to post Security, as applicable, and (3) Q737 El Sunset Park will then have **five (5) Business Days** to pay cash or post Security.
