

IMPORTANT NOTICE – RESPONSE REQUIRED ON OR BEFORE August 3, 2020

Re: Notice of the Expedited Deliverability Study Start Date

Dear Stakeholders:

The start date for the second Expedited Deliverability Study (EDS), e.g., EDS 2020-02, will be **August 3, 2020** (EDS Start Date).

Pursuant to Section 25.5.9.2.1 of the Attachment S to the ISO OATT, a Developer is eligible to enter an EDS if all of the following requirements have been satisfied:

- NYISO receives notice of Developer's request (request should be sent to NYISO via email to <u>InterconnectionSupport@nyiso.com</u> by 5 PM Eastern Standard Time on the EDS Start Date;
- For projects requesting to enter the EDS and that are requesting Capacity Resource Interconnection Service (CRIS) in a Mitigated Capacity Zone, the Developer must have satisfied the data submission requirements set forth in Section 23.4.5.7.3.6 of the ISO Services Tariff and have such data submission deemed complete by the ISO by the EDS Start Date; and
- 3. Project must be in service or have completed one of the following, as applicable:
 - i. a Class Year Study for Energy Resource Interconnection Service (ERIS);
 - ii. a System Impact Study under the Small Generator Interconnection Procedures; or
 - iii. a utility interconnection study if the facility is not subject to the ISO interconnection procedures under Attachment X and Z.

As soon as practicable after the NYISO confirms that the Developer has satisfied the above eligibility requirements, , the NYISO shall tender an EDS Agreement (EDSA) in the form of Appendix 2 to the Attachment S to the ISO OATT.

To enter the EDS, the Developer must, within ten (10) Business Days after the NYISO tenders the EDSA, the Developer must complete the EDSA and deliver (1) the completed agreement, (2) the required technical data and (3) a study deposit of \$30,000 to the ISO.

The Developer, ISO and Connecting Transmission Owner shall execute the EDSA no later than ten (10) Calendar Days after the ISO confirms receipt of the executed EDSA, the required technical data and required deposit from the Developer.
