October 6, 2006	September 2006 Initial Invoice issued
October 20, 2006	Date proposed by some Transmission Owners for Tie & Generator metering to be permanently locked down
November 13-17, 2006	Five business-day period during which Meter Authorities should submit Tie & Generator metering revisions
November 28, 2006	Point, five business-days prior to end of the 60-day review & correction period, in which Meter Authorities will be precluded from initiating Tie & Generator metering revisions
December 1, 2006	Point, three business-days prior to end of the 60-day review & correction period, in which Generators & Non-Meter Authorities will be precluded from initiating Tie & Generator metering revisions
December 6, 2006	Point in which no further Tie & Generator metering revisions allowed
December 21-29, 2006	Five business-day period during which Meter Authorities should submit Retail Load metering (TOL files) for the four-month true-up
January 8, 2007	Point, 30 days prior to issuance of the four-month true-up, in which LSE advisory settlement statements are available for LSEs' review
January 30, 2007	Point, prior to issuance of the four-month true-up, in which LSEs metering will be precluded from revision until the true-up is invoiced
February 7, 2007	Four-month true-up invoiced
February 19-23, 2007	Five business-day period during which Meter Authorities should submit Retail Load metering (TOL files) for the six-month true-up
March 7, 2007	Point, 30 days prior to issuance of the six-month true-up, in which LSE advisory settlement statements are available for LSEs' review
March 29, 2007	Point, prior to issuance of the six-month true-up, in which LSEs will be precluded from submitting further requests to revise their metering data
April 6, 2007	Six-month true-up invoiced and no further revision to LSE metering allowed
