

# NYISO Management Committee Meeting

## Special Meeting by Conference Call

December 16, 2002

### MINUTES OF THE MEETING

#### 1. Introduction and Meeting Objectives

Mr. Brown called the meeting to order at 10:55 AM and welcomed the members of the Management Committee ("MC"). He announced that the committee would be taking action on two items, related to credit requirements and challenging final bills.

#### 2. Motion to Approve Proposed Revisions to Credit Requirements Contained in NYISO Tariffs

Since the proposed Financial Assurance Requirements had been discussed in detail in a number of lower committee meetings, Mr. Gootee asked the committee members if they desired to hear his presentation of the proposal. Hearing no requests, Mr. Brown asked for and received a motion, and a second, to approve the proposal.

##### Motion #1:

**Motion to approve proposed tariff revisions to Financial Assurance Requirements as presented to the Management Committee on Monday, December 16, 2002, and including the following revisions to the document titled *Proposed Comprehensive Financial Assurance Requirements – Key Terms*:**

- modify Page 14, Section XIV.D, "Notice to customers", to provide that the NYISO shall notify all Market Participants in the event that a customer has defaulted as well as when a default has been cured
- Add, under Page 4. V.E, the following language: "Which could have a material impact on the customer's financial condition".
- Existing surety bonds would be effective for a maximum of 12 months.

Mr. Kinney moved to clarify the original amendment by removing the Loss Sharing and Working Capital requirements from the Financial Assurance requirements, and specifying that those requirements should be discussed at the January BIC meeting.

##### Motion #2:

**Motion to amend motion #1 to add:**

**Further, the loss sharing and working capital requirements will be removed from the Finance Assurance Requirements. Market Participants will continue to work on the loss sharing policy that applies to all customers and will develop an appropriate working capital allocation policy to be included in the Financial Assurance Requirements. The remaining provisions of the proposal to be**

filed at FERC with implementation pending resolution and approval of the full policy by FERC. The loss sharing and working capital policy to be presented for discussion and action at the January BIC meeting.

***(Motion#2 failed with 46.14 % affirmative votes)***

Mr. Butterklee reiterated the concern that Consolidated Edison has with the 120% cap and reserved Consolidated Edison's right to appeal the committee's decision.

A roll-call vote was conducted for Motion #1.

***(Motion#1 failed with 57.09 % affirmative votes)***

Mr. Brown said that he would wait for feedback before sending the issue back to a working group.

### **3. Motion to Amend Tariffs by Adding Procedures for Administering Customer Challenges of Final Settlement Information**

Mr. Deaver explained that following the approval of the Final Settlement proposal was approved by the MC during the June 13, 2002 meeting, Transmission Owners appealed to the Board on the grounds that recovering amounts for final bill challenges through RS1 would create inequities. The Board of Director agreed with the appeal and directed staff to propose an equitable solution. The current proposal eliminates the need to use RS1 to collect charges for final bill challenges, and provides for inter-party adjustments.

#### **Motion #3:**

#### **Motion To Amend Tariffs By Adding Procedures For Administering Customer Challenges Of Final Settlement Information**

WHEREAS, the Management Committee and the Business Issues Committee, on May 22, 2002 and June 13, 2002 respectively, approved a recommendation that NYISO staff prepare and that the Board jointly with the Management Committee authorize the filing of proposed amendments to the Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff ("Services Tariff") and the Open Access Transmission Tariff ("OATT") regarding procedures for the administration of Customer challenges to the accuracy of settlement information in their final billing invoices; and,

WHEREAS, the NYISO Board of Directors subsequently granted, in part, an appeal of the Management Committee's June 13, 2002 approval of said recommendation and directed NYISO staff to prepare a tariff amendment to provide for the funding of valid bill challenges through inter-Customer billing adjustments (*i.e.* rebilling the service months in question) rather than through socializing the costs of such adjustments over the current Customer base through a Rate Schedule 1 charge.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Management Committee approves funding valid bill challenges through inter-Customer billing adjustments rather than through Rate Schedule 1 charges. Further, the information on slide 11 of the presentation has been revised in that the policy will be submitted to FERC, within 30 days if possible, with a request for expedited treatment and will be implemented upon FERC approval. Tariff language to be reviewed and approved by the Chairs and Vice Chairs

**of the MC and BIC upon review by the Billing and Accounting Working Group.**

Mr. Butterklee requested that the term “expedited treatment” be clarified and was told by Mr. Brown that expedited means within thirty days. Mr. Scheiderich asked if the BAWG would need to approve the tariff language, and Mr. Brown explained that committee chairs and vice-chairs would be approving. In response to Ms. Saia’s question, Mr. Deaver explained that the hold harmless provision of the original proposal would not remain intact, and that the possibility would now exist for a participant to receive a charge as the result of another participant’s challenge. He also explained that only one month will be challenged at a time. Mr. Nachmias was told that a de minimus threshold had not yet been established.

*(Motion passed unanimously with abstentions, by polling members for abstentions and objections)*
