




Northeast States—Payroll Employment One-year vs. 3-month performance (3 mo. MA)




Northeast States—Payroll Employment One-year vs. 3-month performance (3 mo. MA)



Northeast Metro Areas—Payroll Employment One-year vs. 3-month performance (3 mo. MA)






Downstate Suffering From Housing, Finance

Employment, % change year ago, 3 mo. MA




Weak Dollar and Global Expansion Provide Support

Case-Shiller home price index, % change from peak




...But Credit Quality Is Eroding Rapidly

First mortgage delinquency rate, % of \$ volume




Income Trends Are Eroding in Much of the State


Per capita income relative to U.S., U.S.=100

Diffusion index, 3 mo. MA






Metro Area Growth Will Be Mixed

Average annual employment growth, 2008Q2 to 2009Q2




Goods-Producing & Finance Will Drag Growth

Average annual employment growth, 2008Q2 to 2009Q2




New York's Population Will Fall as Boomers Leave

Population growth, %





Securities brokerage industry




Wall Street Layoffs Have Yet to Fully Hit NYC...




Tourism Still Strong but Slowing in New York City




Midtown Office Market Reflects Weakness as Well
