Dear Ms. Lampi:

On March 11, 2009, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (NYISO) submitted revised tariff sheets to its Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff and its Open Access Transmission Tariff. The revised tariff sheets were accepted for filing on May 15, 2009. NYISO has since determined that the March 11 filing inadvertently moved existing language from Tariff Sheet No. 276.06 to Tariff Sheet No. 276B. This filing corrects that error. The tariff sheets are accepted effective May 12, 2009, as requested.¹

Public notice of the filing was published in the Federal Register with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before October 22, 2009. No interventions, protests, or adverse comments were filed.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or

service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against NYISO.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713 (2009).
