

2016 RNA: External Capacity Sales

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Background

 This presentation defines the treatment in the Reliability Needs Assessment (RNA) of NYCA capacity sold forward to external control areas.

RNA Treatment of Capacity Sold Forward to External Control Areas

- Generation selling out through the external areas forward capacity market will be modeled in the RNA Base Cases as equivalent contracts to reflect current obligations;
- The generation will then be assumed to return to the NY market after the expiration of the contract for the remaining years of the Study Period; and
- A scenario analysis will be performed to assess the potential impact to reliability if a generator continues to sell out in the remaining years of the Study Period.
