RCIS.

NYISO WAS ALREADY TAKING ACTIONS TO REMOVE POST CONTINGENCY VIOLATIONS ON THIS LINE CAUSED BY A LARGE SCHEDULE CHANGE TO IESO. NY WAS CUTTING CONTRACTS FROM PJM AND TO HQ, ALSO TAP MOVES WERE ALSO BEING TAKEN ON THE 5018 AND

L33/34.
