Settlement Status

- As previously discussed, we are way behind in closing the ISO monthly settlements
- It is being proposed that we look at a business resolution to put as many months behind us once and for all
 - Idea is to reduce risks to MP going forward
 - Allow staff at ISO and MP orgs to concentrate on more current issues

Settlement Status

- What is being done about the situation?
 - J Oates had a call 9-17 including several MPs and ISO staff to discuss this issue
 - The following approach was vetted at BIC on 9-22:
 - Form a group reporting directly to BIC to address possible "out-ofthe-box" solutions to this problem
 - Anticipates that settlements through 2000 would be completed as originally contemplated
 - Known issues would be resolved in the settlement
 - May involve some triaging of the issues
 - Legal opinion will be sought if we see a need to deviate from governing Tariff provisions

 - Formed "BIRT" Business Issues Resolution Team...
 - Kevin Kipers, Ray Kinney, Jim Scheiderich, Wes Yeomans, Glenn Haake, Bill Heinrich, Ed Aguayo (NOT exclusive...)
 - Appropriate staff
 - Initial efforts will concentrate on:
 - Gathering information from the ISO
 - Scoping out the effort
 - Developing recommendations
- We are awaiting our first meeting

Settlement Timeline

- Up through 9-02:
 - 2 year "final" bill
 - 1 year challenge period
 - Market start thru 9-01 on the table
 - Undefined "Reasonable" period
 - 30 day final review
 - Month closeout
- After 9-02:
 - 1 year "final" bill
 - 4 month challenge period
 - 10-02 thru 5-03 theoretically on the table
 - Undefined "Reasonable" period
 - 30 day final review
 - Month closeout
