MOTION TO INTERVENE OF THE NEW YORK INDEPENDENT SYSTEM OPERATOR, INC.

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 15(d) and Rule 15(b) of the Circuit Rules of this Court, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. ("NYISO"), by counsel, hereby moves to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding. In support of this motion, the NYISO states:

- 1. The NYISO is a New York not-for-profit corporation formed under New York law.

 Although it does not own or control any electric power generation facilities, it possesses operational control over the transmission facilities in New York State. The NYISO is the independent body responsible for providing open access transmission service, maintaining reliability, and administering competitive wholesale electricity markets in New York State. The NYISO fulfills these responsibilities pursuant to certain tariffs and orders of the respondent Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC").
- 2. In this case, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Petitioner") seeks review of the following FERC order:

Consolidated Edison Co. of New York, Inc. v. Public Service Electric and Gas Co., PJM Interconnection, L.L.C., and New York Independent System Operator, Inc., Order Denying Rehearing, 120 FERC ¶ 61,161, Docket No. EL02-23-003 (Aug. 15, 2007).

3. Because the FERC order at issue relates to a complaint filed by Petitioner that named the NYISO, as well as other entities, as respondents, the NYISO has a substantial and direct interest in this proceeding that is distinct from those of all other parties and thus cannot be adequately represented by any other party. The NYISO may be adversely affected by a resolution in this proceeding unless it is permitted to participate. Consequently, the NYISO seeks to intervene herein. \(^1\)

WHEREFORE, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. respectfully requests that it be permitted to intervene in this proceeding and granted all rights as a party hereto.
