GT Under-generation Penalty Assessment

- Penalties for GT Under-generation
 - ▶ Penalties have been incurred by GT owners due to the inability of many units to derate when environmental conditions limit unit performance below bid UOL
 - ▶ Applicable penalties are those incurred from June 2003 through present
 - ▶ Penalties will continue until software changes are made to adjust UOL to actual or provide web-based user interface to allow MP adjustment.



ISO Recommendations

- Forgive GT under-generation penalties for on-line GT units
 - ▶ Forgive penalties incurred from GT dragging fix (June 2003) to present
 - ▶ Suspend penalties for GT under-generation pending SMD addition of web based derate function
 - ▶ Total GT penalties through November, 2004, should not exceed \$750,000 at the historic GT penalty rate of approximately \$50,000 per month
- Reviewed at S&P on July 14th; seek BIC approval for such a resolution for presentation to the August MC meeting.



Recommendations – SMD2

> GT Dragging

- There are a couple of options available to address GT derates in SMD, either in MIS or in the dispatch software.
- Neither option can make the code freeze date, but are relatively minor projects that could be incorporated post SMD2 deployment.
- Incorporate as a project and prioritize.
