- ◆ **Schedule Joint ESPWG and TPAS meeting with final review and discussion of desired scenarios.**

- ◆ **NYISO proposed scenarios:**
 - 1. Indian Point Plant Retirement**
 - 2. Higher load forecast**
 - 3. Higher Natural Gas Prices**
 - 4. Increased Environmental Costs**
- ◆ **Additional Scenarios for 3 Studies**

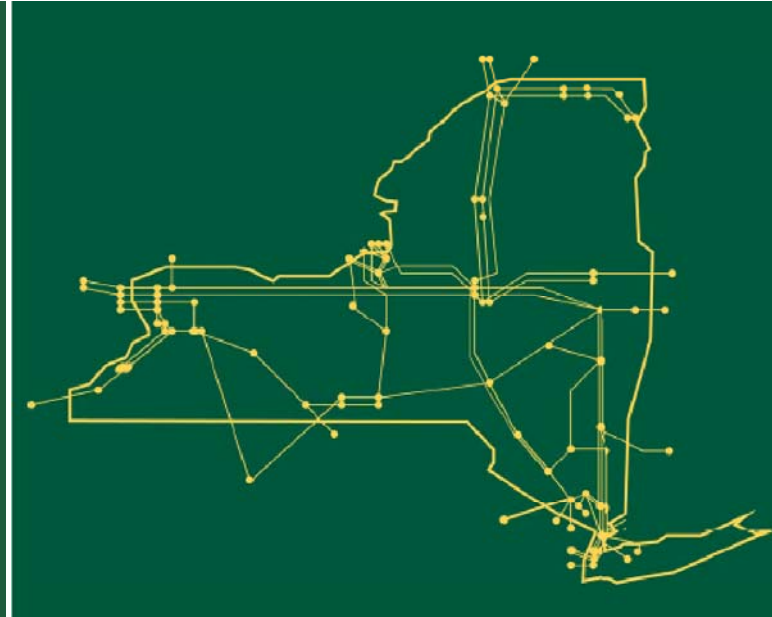
