Background

- **Jan 20th Joint Interconnection Compliance Filing**

- **Feb 9th Joint Petition for Clarification Filed**
 - *Requests FERC to clarify that existing procedures remain in place in New York until FERC acts on Compliance Filing*

- **Feb 10th Interventions, comments, protests due**
 - *Several comments/protests were received*
 - *Protestors had a positive reaction to overall Compliance Filing*
 - *NYISO and TO's are reviewing comments*

Several Types of Follow-Up Issues

➤ Transition Issues: NYISO Staff/TPAS

- *Effective Date Re: FERC Jan 8th Order*
 - ▶ Request for clarification filed on Feb 9th
- *Identify entities likely to be in transition*

➤ Attachment S Issues: NYISO Staff/TPAS

- *Related to Compliance Filing*
- *Other Issues*

➤ Settlement-related issues: FERC/NYISO Staff/TPAS

- *Tariff related*
- *Procedural*

Types of Follow-Up Issues (Cont'd)

- **NYISO Procedures: NYISO Staff/TPAS**
 - *Revise as needed to implement Compliance Filing*
 - *Revise as needed to implement settlement*

- **Related Issues: Parallel Process**
 - *Separable from implementation issues*
 - *Deliverability Study*
 - ▶ IITF – Joint BIC/OC group
 - ▶ Glenn Haake has agreed to Chair IITF for this effort
 - ▶ All interested parties are invited to participate
 - *Modify IA to accommodate Merchant Transmission*
 - ▶ Informal working group reporting to TPAS?
 - ▶ NYISO has requested comments/statement of interest
