ADD – Design Considerations

- ➤ This interface will be limited to retrieving Settlement Days / Versions that are stored in the DSS.
- This interface will be limited to retrieving individual data elements that are stored in the DSS.
- Once settlement days are re-spun for un-invoiced days and versions, the prior version of data is over-written. The DSS only retains one uninvoiced version of the data at any time (version 0).
- > The DSS is only loaded once per day, so requesting the same day and version of data within the same day is redundant. Polling the system for changes more than once per day is unnecessary.



ADD – Known Issues

> Due to the Differences in Versioning Strategies:

- Update vs. Insert
 - ▶ DSS keeps all un-invoiced versions of settlements data as V0. Therefore, as un-invoiced data is re-settled in BAS, we will re-issue V0.
- Un-Invoiced Data vs. Invoiced Data
 - ▶ There will have to be specific consideration of how to publish reports via ADD for invoiced data sets. Proposal is to automatically publish un-invoiced data, and allow users to request invoiced sets manually, if desired.

> Filename Change

The advisory file names will need to include Organization Name.

> Error Corrections

DSS ADD Training Plan

➤ What is the ADD Training Plan?

- DSS ADD Training Course
 - A temporary training course targeted towards people who have already attended the DSS Introduction Course and want to learn how to use DSS ADD.

DSS – Did You Know?

> NYISO Employees are Using DSS!

- Today's Example: NYISO Customer Relations
 - ▶ Responding to a Common CRD Billing Question from Market Participants
- Example:
 - Reconciling Curtailed in Hour Transactions
- Business Scenario:
 - MPs call NYISO CRD to assist in reconciliation.
 - Prior to DSS:
 - MPs had limited access to the data required to reconcile the energy (MWh) and settlements (\$) associated with these Transactions
 - CRD would gather data from MIS, capture it into a MS Excel file, manually re-calculate the MWhs and related settlement (\$), tie it out to the invoice, then send out the data to MP (~2-3 hours work).
 - With DSS:
 - CRD has improved the process... CRD created a custom report so they just open the report, refresh it, customize further if desired, tie it out to the invoice, then send out the data to MP (~minutes).
 - The custom report organizes the required data into a single report, that allows an MP to easily reconcile.
