Additional Information

- The Data Dictionary contains a new optional parameter (FRP_Confirmed).
- As this parameter is optional, it is not necessary to modify an input file in order to receive a response file.
- The addition of the FRP_Confirmed parameter will cause the response file to display bids that contain the value indicated by the parameter (For example if the input file includes a FRP_CONFIRMED parameter that equals 'Y', the response file will only return bids whose FRP_Confirmed value = 'Y').
- Omission of this parameter will allow the response file to return bids that have a FRP_Confirmed value of 'Y' or 'N'
