The Commission staff is requesting additional information in order to further evaluate the request for rehearing in the above referenced docket. Therefore, please provide the additional information requested below.

1. For the 24 month period of September 1999 to August 2001, provide the average aggregate EFOR_d rate for the mitigated in-city generators. The EFOR_d rate is to be calculated consistent (using 24 months instead of 12 months) with the method used to determine the UCAP of this set of generators.
2. For the 36 month period of September 1998 to August 2001, provide the average aggregate EFOR_d rate for the mitigated in-city generators. The EFOR_d rate is to be calculated consistent (using 36 months instead of 12 months) with the method used to determine the UCAP of this set of generators.
