## NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF TIME

(November 1, 2004)

On October 26, 2004, the Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., New York Independent System Operator, Inc., PJM Interconnection, L.L.C., and Public Service Electric Service and Gas Company (together, Parties) filed a joint motion for an extension of time to file an operating protocol, in compliance with ordering paragraph (C) of the Commission's Order (Order) issued August 2, 2004, in the above-docketed proceeding. 108 FERC ¶ 61, 120 (2004). The motion states that the Parties have worked diligently to develop a mutually acceptable operating protocol, held several technical discussions to address complex issues, and conducted many meetings to reach a proposed solution, but that due to the broad scope and complex nature of the requirements of the August 2 Order, more time is needed to comply with the requirements of ordering paragraph (C). The motion also states that the Parties have committed to continue working towards an agreement that resolves the outstanding issues in this proceeding.

Upon consideration, notice is hereby given that an extension of time to comply with the Commission's August 2, 2004 Order is granted to and including January 18, 2005, as requested by the Parties.
