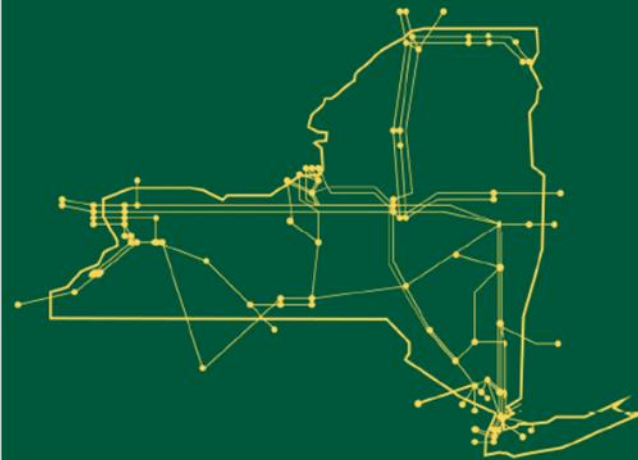
Summary of Changes
