**MOTION OF NEW YORK INDEPENDENT SYSTEM OPERATOR, INC.
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO SUBMIT
VIRTUAL TRADING REPORT FOR THE SUMMER 2002 CAPABILITY PERIOD**

The New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (“NYISO”), pursuant to Rule 212 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18 C.F.R. § 385.212, hereby submits this motion for an extension of time of two weeks for the NYISO to submit the report on virtual trading for the Summer 2002 Capability Period specified in the Commission’s Order Accepting Virtual Bidding Proposal and Mitigation Measures and Directing Compliance Filing (“Virtual Trading Order”) in the above dockets, 97 FERC ¶ 61,091 (October 25, 2001).


The Virtual Trading Order directs the NYISO “to file a report describing its experience with virtual bidding within 30 days of the end of each of the first four capability periods, starting with the Winter 2001-2002 capability period.” The Market Monitoring and Performance Department of the NYISO has prepared a draft of the NYISO’s report for the Summer 2002 Capability Period. The date for filing this report, however falls on the Friday after Thanksgiving (November 29). Because of Holiday schedules, it will not be possible for the NYISO to complete the necessary reviews of the draft report and put it in form for filing with the Commission by the first business day following the 30th day from the end of the Summer 2002

Capability period (*i.e.*, December 2, 2002). According, the NYISO requests an extension of time of two weeks for filing this report, or until December 16, 2002.

WHEREFORE, for the above-stated reasons, the NYISO requests that the Commission extend the due date for the report specified in the Virtual Trading Order for two weeks, or until December 16, 2002.

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
